RESULT OF CONSULTATION RE: 2020 AGM AND ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

Dear Colleagues/SRN Members

As you will remember, last month the Executive Council issued a special Call to Membership (CTM) and Resolution as a way of consulting the membership and calling action by expressing a preference for one of two options re: this year's AGM and related EC elections via related Google Forms survey. At the monthly meeting held on Monday 22 June 2020, the Executive Council collected all the responses received by the deadline of 19 June 2020. Although participation was rather low-ish, on behalf of the EC I herewith inform all Members of the result of the consultation, which saw 100% of respondents seconding the recommended resolution to:

- **Delay/postpone this year's AGM to the 2021 Annual Conference**
- **Extend the mandate of current EC members by one year, and**
- **Delay/postpone the next EC elections to the 2021 Annual Conference**

We would like to thank all the colleagues who took the time to express their preference as well as several other members for the kind words and the support we received over the past few months in regards to the extra-ordinary (and at times tough) decisions we had to make.

As we move into the long Summer (at least in the Northern Hemisphere) break, we will be back in touch soon with the Call for Nominations for the role of Early Career Representative, the next issue of the Newsletter will be out in July, and we will be back in September with the Annual Report of the Executive Council, and the Action Plan for next year which will include a number of exciting new initiatives to be launched in the forthcoming months.
